Each and every year, Labor Day weekend marks a very prestigious event in Guthrie County — The Guthrie County Fair! For over 150 years, the fair was a means to celebrate the people, the youth, the businesses, the culture, and all else Guthrie County has to offer. The fair has always been a constant, a destination point, for many Guthrie County residents, but "constant" doesn't mean change can't happen. Over the past several years, many buildings that were constant fixtures during the fair have been taken down and replaced with new, upgraded facilities. We are at that point again. One of the last remaining structures—the showring—has been around for 70+ years and has been the grand stage for 4–H and FFA youth to showcase their livestock at the fair. After a lengthy design and research process, the Guthrie County Fair Board (GCFB) has made the decision to remove the old facility and construct a new showring complex, complete with restrooms, kitchen, office space, storage space, wash racks, and bleachers.

With the construction of the new showring facility comes a hefty financial burden, but it truly is an investment in our youth. The overall cost is expected to be around \$700,000. A March 2023 fundraiser netted a little over \$100,000 with all proceeds allocated to the new project. To date, with some additional funds, cash on hand totals a little over \$112,000. The GCFB is reaching out to ask for your financial support in being a partner in the new facility so our youth have a place to show for many generations to come.

All donation/sponsorship levels will be proudly displayed inside of the new showring and 100% of the proceeds will go toward the completion of the showring project. Your consideration is greatly appreciated in helping fund the showring capital campaign.

The Guthrie County Fair Board is starting something new as another way to give in support of the Guthrie County Fair and their endeavors. Starting Sept 1, 2023, the Guthrie County Fair Board will have accounts set up at the following locations for grain to be placed in care of the GCFB to support ongoing projects on the grounds. For the foreseeable future, the contributions will go directly toward the showring project.

Farmers may donate 50 bushels or whole semi-load, it's truly at your discretion. When going across the scale, just specify what amount you'd like to put into the GCFB's name. When contracts are filled and you have grain still on wheels, it's a great time to remember the GCFB.

Another option for the fall of 2023, we can come to you in the field and you can off load from the grain cart directly onto our semi. The GCFB has already lined up semis in October to come directly to your field, bring you and your crew some lunch, and you can donate some grain to the showring cause right from the field. There will be more details on dates as we get closer to harvest, so please listen to KSOM, KJAN, 107.9, Facebook, and the local newspapers for more exact dates.

The donation accounts will be set up in perpetuity, so when the showring project is paid for, the accounts will remain open for future donations toward projects and upkeep of the grounds.
