Pre-entry is not required.

Entries may be made the day of the show on Saturday.

Show Guidelines-

- This is not a terminal show. All pigs are to be retained by the exhibitor after the show
- Weigh cards will be submitted at the fairgrounds prior to the show
- Pen space is not guaranteed. Exhibitors should plan to show off trailers
- Exhibitors may enter barrows or gilts
- 4-H and FFA exhibitors may enter their hogs in open class
- There is no limit of number of pigs per exhibitor
- There are no weight restrictions
- Classes will be divided according to pig weights
- Separate barrow and gilt classes will be made if entry numbers allow.
- Purebred classes will be made if entry numbers allows.
- Entry fee is \$20 for each pig
- Pigs shown in the Guthrie County 4-H and FFA show will be a charged a \$10 entry fee if entered in open class also.
- Number of entries and class size will determine class premiums
- There will be youth showmanship classes offered for youth exhibitors age 21 and younger
