- If pens space is available, rabbits may be housed in the small animal barn. Cage rental fee must be paid to the superintendent when entry is made.
- Padlocks are required for cages.

(Lot 5) Intermediate Doe, 6-8 mo
(Lot 6) Junior Doe, under 6 mo

CLASS 2 – MIXED BREED
(Lot 1) Senior Buck, over 6 mo
(Lot 2) Junior Buck, under 6 mo
(Lot 3) Senior Doe, over 6 mo
(Lot 4) Junior Doe, under 6 mo
Grand Champion Mixed Bred - Ribbon
Reserve Champion Mixed Bred - Ribbon

CLASS 3 – FANCY PUREBRED

(Lot 1) Senior Buck, over 6 mo

CLASS 4 - MEAT PEN

- Entry consists of a pen of 3 rabbits, 3-5 pounds each and under 69 days of age.
- For purpose of uniformity rabbits should come from the same litter.
- Entries may be purebred or mixed breed.
